The night of the seder is a night focused on what is truly most important.

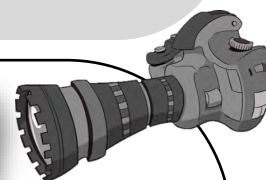
It is a special night dedicated to strengthening our emuna in Hashem, recognizing his direct involvement in our lives and transferring our mesora of emuna to the next generation.

It is this excitement that primes our children's hearts to be"H soak in the precious lessons of emuna they will receive from their parents during the seder night.

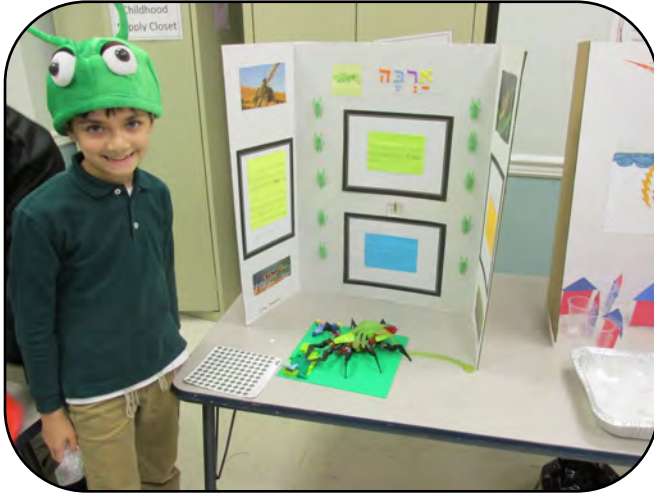
How fortunate we are to have Chag HaPesach - it is something truly worth being excited about!

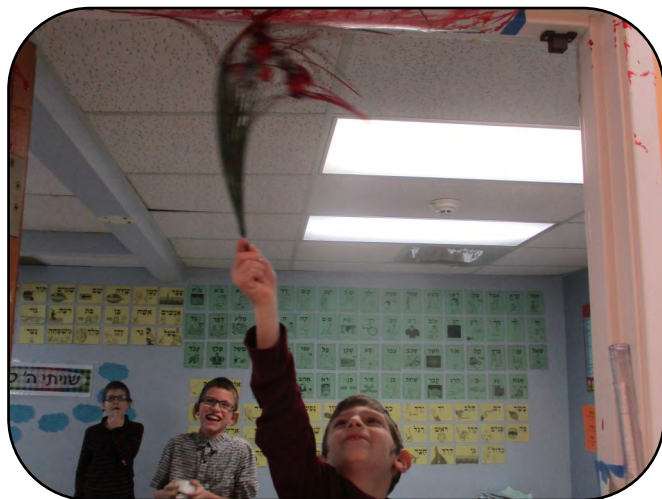

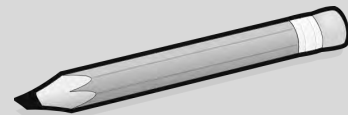
